28 76-6-112. Agricultural operation interference -- Penalties. 29 (1) As used in this section, "agricultural operation" means the commercial production 30 of crops, orchards, aquaculture, livestock, poultry, livestock products, or poultry products, and 31 the facilities, equipment, or property used to facilitate the commercial production. 32 (2) A person is guilty of agricultural operation interference if the person, without 33 consent from the owner of the operation, or the owner's agent, knowingly or intentionally 34 records an image of, or sound from, the operation: 35 (a) while the person is on the property where the agricultural operation is located; or 36 (b) by leaving a recording device on the property where the agricultural operation is 37 located. (3) A person who commits agricultural operation interference is guilty of: 38

(a) for a first offense, a class A misdemeanor; or

(b) for a subsequent offense, a felony of the third degree.
