

# WORKING DRAFT -- FOR DISCUSSION PURPOSES ONLY

*Note -- This proposed legislation is drafted with the intent that it will not be numbered as a bill until the Transportation Committee recommended bill titled Special Group License Plate Revisions is passed and signed by the governor during the 2003 General Session. This is necessary because this proposed legislation is drafted based on a proposed section of the code that has not yet been enacted by the Legislature.*

## HONORARY CONSULATE SPECIAL GROUP LICENSE PLATES

This Act modifies the Motor Vehicle Code by adding an Honorary Consulate special group license plate. This act takes effect on October 1, 2003.

### Statutory text:

#### **41-1a-418 (Section Effective January ?? 2003) Authorized Special Group License Plates.**

(1) The division shall only issue special group license plates in accordance with Sections 41-1a-418 through 41-1a-422 to a person who is specified under this section within the categories listed as follows:

(a) disability special group license plates issued in accordance with Section 41-1a-420;

(b) honor special group license plates, as in a war hero, which plates are issued for a:

(i) survivor of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor;

(ii) former prisoner of war; or

(iii) recipient of a Purple Heart;

(c) unique vehicle type special group license plates, as for historical, collectors value, or other unique vehicle type, which plates are issued for a:

- 26 (i) special interest vehicle;
- 27 (ii) vintage vehicle;
- 28 (iii) farm truck; or
- 29 (iv) vehicle powered by clean fuel and for which a current clean special fuel certificate is
- 30 maintained as provided in Section 59-13-304;
- 31 (d) recognition special group license plates, as in a public official or an emergency service
- 32 giver, which plates are issued for a:
- 33 (i) current member of the Legislature;
- 34 (ii) current member of the United States Congress;
- 35 (iii) current member of the National Guard;
- 36 (iv) licensed amateur radio operator;
- 37 (v) currently employed, volunteer, or retired firefighter;
- 38 (vi) emergency medical technician; ~~or~~
- 39 (vii) current member of a search and rescue team; ~~and~~ or
- 40 (viii) current honorary consulate designated by the United States Department of State; and
- 41 (e) support special group license plates, as for a contributor to an institution or cause, which
- 42 plates are issued for a contributor to:
- 43 (i) an institution's scholastic scholarship fund;
- 44 (ii) the Division of Wildlife Resources;
- 45 (iii) the Office of Veterans' Affairs;
- 46 (iv) the Division of Parks and Recreation;
- 47 (v) the Department of Agriculture and Food;
- 48 (vi) the Guardian Ad Litem Services Account and the Children's Museum of Utah;
- 49 (vii) the Boy Scouts of America; or
- 50 (viii) spay and neuter programs through No More Homeless Pets in Utah.
- 51 (2) Beginning January 1, 2003, the division may not issue a new type of special group license
- 52 plate unless the division receives:
- 53 (a) a start-up fee established under Section 63-38-3.2 for production and administrative costs
- 54 for providing the new special group license plates; or
- 55 (b) a legislative appropriation for the start-up fee provided under Subsection (2)(a).
- 56 (3) (a) A sponsoring organization that qualifies for tax-exempt status under Internal Revenue

57 Code Section 501(c) may request the commission to authorize a new type of special group license plate  
58 for the sponsoring organization. The sponsoring organization shall:

59 (i) collect a minimum of 200 applications; and

60 (ii) pay a start-up fee established under Section 63-38-3.2 for production and administrative  
61 costs for providing the new type of special group license plates.

62 (b) If the provisions of Subsection (3)(a) are met, the commission shall approve the request and  
63 the division shall:

64 (i) design a license plate in accordance with Section 41-1a-419; and

65 (ii) issue the new type of special group license plates.

66 **Section 2. Effective date.**

67 **This act takes effect on October 1, 2003.**
