- 3:10** **4. Report—New Hospital and Clinic Quality Measures**
Legislation passed during the 2011 Annual General Session (H.B. 128, "Health Reform Amendments"), required the Department of Health, beginning July 1, 2012, to publish measures that compare the quality of care across hospitals and clinics for diabetes, heart disease, and other conditions, and for routine and preventive care. (These are in addition to existing reports on health care facility charges, quality, and safety.) The legislation required the quality measures to first be published in a statewide aggregated format, which does not compare individual facilities, no later than December 1, 2012, and required that at least five new measures be added each year until July 1, 2015. As required by statute, the committee will receive a report from the Department of Health on the new measures to be added to the report.
