| 22       | 53-7-203. Utah Fire Prevention Board Creation Members Terms                        |
| 23       | Selection of chair and officers Quorum Meetings Compensation Division's duty       |
| 24       | to implement board rules.  |
| 25       | (1) There is created within the division the Utah Fire Prevention Board.           |
| 26       | (2) The board shall be nonpartisan and be composed of [13] 11 members appointed by |
| 27       | the governor as follows:   |
| 28       | [(a) a city or county official;]   |
| 29       | [(b)] (a) a licensed architect;  |
| 30       | [(c)] (b) a licensed engineer;   |
| 31       | [(d)] (c) a member of the Utah State Firemen's Association;                        |
| 32       | [(e)] (d) the state forester or the state forester's designee;                     |

| 48 | time of appointment or reappointment, adjust the length of terms to ensure that the terms of |
| 49 | board members are staggered so that approximately half of the board is appointed every two   |
| 50 | years.   |
| 51 | (4) When a vacancy occurs in the membership for any reason, the replacement shall be         |
| 52 | appointed for the unexpired term.  |
| 53 | (5) A member whose term has expired may continue to serve until a replacement is             |
| 54 | appointed pursuant to Subsection (3).  |
| 55 | (6) The board shall select from its members a chair and other officers as the board finds    |
| 56 | necessary.   |
| 57 | (7) A majority of the members of the board is a quorum.                                      |
| 58 | (8) The board shall hold regular semiannual meetings for the transaction of its business     |
| 59 | at a time and place to be fixed by the board and shall hold other meetings as necessary for  |

| 61 | (9) A member may not receive compensation or benefits for the member's service, but          |
