1. H.B. 200 Sexual Assault Kit Processing Amendments (Romero, A.)

 - 79 gather and preserve biological and physical evidence following an allegation of sexual assault
 - 80 { and may include selected swabs of biological evidence that is contained in a Uquik kit } __.
