**1. Call to Order** - Chair Evans called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

**2. Committee Business** -

**MOTION:** Sen. Jones noted a correction on the September 28, 1999 minutes. In the last sentence on page one, delete "by" and insert the word "be." Rep. Bradshaw moved to approve the corrected minutes of September 28, 1999. The motion passed unanimously.

**3. Review of the Utah Tomorrow Report** -

**Government Section** - Mr. Ray Milliner, Governor's Office of Planning and Budget, and Ms. Amy Naccarato, Director, Elections Office, discussed issues from the last meeting regarding the Government section of the Utah Tomorrow Report. Ms. Naccarato clarified the process of removing names from voting rosters. Committee discussion followed.

**Education Section** - Mr. Cannon mentioned that the Education section is still being completed. He suggested it be presented to the committee at a subsequent meeting.

**Culture Section** - Mr. Milliner presented the Culture section. He distributed an update of this section titled "Culture." Mr. Milliner told the committee that more information was being compiled from the humanities organizations.

Mr. Dan Burke, Department of Community and Economic Development, Division of Museum Services, and Ms. Amy Owen, Department of Community and Economic Development,

State Library Administrator, answered questions from the committee. Committee discussion followed.

**Health and Safety Section** - Ms. Lois Haggard, Department of Health, presented the Health and Safety Section. Sen. Jones suggested statistics reflecting the number of unwanted pregnancy cases and abortions be considered. Committee discussion followed.

**Economic Development Section** - Mr. Doug Jex, Department of Community and Economic Development, Division of Business and Economic Development, spoke about the Economic Development section. He noted changes that from the last presentation of this section at the August 17, 1999 meeting. Committee discussion followed.

**Justice Section** - Mr. Chevan Nanayakkara, Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice, presented the Justice section to the committee. He answered questions from the committee.

Mr. Becker said that the data in the Justice section could be updated. Committee discussion followed.

Mr. Cannon distributed a list of legislative standing committees for potential review of Utah Tomorrow during the 2000 General Session. He mentioned that the proposed meeting for December 9, 1999 requires approval from the Legislative Management Committee.
