During the 2004 General Session the Legislature passed H.B. 140, "Child and Family Services and Related Judicial Code Amendments." Governor Walker later vetoed the bill, in part due to the introduction of a "mature minor" standard for determining medical neglect. Following the Governor's veto, the Judicial Council's Standing Committee on Children and Family Law began a study of issues related to use of the mature minor concept in Juvenile Court. The Panel will receive a report from the Subcommittee on its work.
