Colorado passed an extensive health care professional transparency statute in 2010

Idaho has a Patient Freedom of Information Act similar to Colorado's Act (IdaCare)

The Colorado and Idaho statutes include all or most of the following: practice location, education/training, other state licenses, board certifications, practice specialties, hospital affiliations, other health care facilities/out of state hospitals, business ownership, employer, employment contracts, health care facility actions, employment terminations US DEA registration, convictions, malpractice claims, malpractice claim refusal, narrative and recognitions, charity care.
