

Elections Code -- Statutory Cleanup (OLRGC -- 5/16/12)

► Amend Subsection 20A-1-201.5 to conform with Section 20A-9-802 and clarify that the Western States Presidential Primary is contingent on legislative appropriation.

- **Subsection 20A-9-802(1)(a)(i):**

Contingent upon legislative appropriation, there is established a Western States Presidential Primary election to be held on the first Tuesday in February in the year in which a presidential election will be held.

- **Proposed Amendment:**

20A-1-201.5. Primary election dates . . .

(3) **Contingent upon legislative appropriation**, [T]he Western States Presidential Primary election shall be held throughout the state on the first Tuesday in February in the year in which a presidential election will be held.

► Amend references to "county" in Subsection 20A-6-401.1(1)(e) because the language is only applicable to municipalities.

- **20A-6-401.1. Ballots for partisan municipal primary elections . . .**

(e) immediately below the perforated ballot stub, the following endorsements are printed in 18-point bold type:

- (i) "Official Primary Ballot for _____ [County] **Municipality**, Utah";
- (ii) the date of the election; and
- (iii) a facsimile of the signature of the [county] **municipal clerk or recorder** and the words "[county] **municipal clerk or recorder**";
