NAME OF STUDY	PRIORITY
85. <b>Capital Punishment</b> - to study and review the costs of incarceration for life, the cost of decades of appeals, the emotional costs for those who must perform the execution, and public opinion regarding capital punishment.	
87. <b>Consolidating Emergency Response Provisions</b> - to study the need for, and potential impact of, consolidating various sections of the existing Utah Code relating to emergency responses.	
89. <b>Correctional Health Care</b> - to study the cost and management of correctional health care (H.B. 312, 2010 General Session).	
90. <b>Crisis Intervention Team Training</b> - to study the training of all police officers in crisis intervention and mental illness.	
93. <b>Enticing a Minor</b> - to study whether to amend current laws regarding enticing a minor to include solicitation, seducing, luring, or enticing even when the offender does not ultimately engage in sexual activity with he minor (H.B. 79).	
102. <b>Voluntary Placement on Sex Offender Registry</b> - to study whether individuals can voluntarily place their names on the sex offender registry as part of an agreement with the victim, or the victim's family, who would prefer not to go through a trial, and whether such a "civil track" mechanism can be created.
