

**DORA Statewide Evaluation  
Utah Criminal Justice Center, University of Utah**

**2012 Preliminary Update  
October 17, 2012**

The Utah Criminal Justice Center has an ongoing contract with the Commission on Criminal and Juvenile Justice (CCJJ) to provide research on DORA. As part of this contract, UCJC is in the process of updating the original study of statewide DORA conducted in fall 2009 (full copy of original report, as well as 2010 and 2011 updated reports are available at: <http://ucjc.utah.edu/>). The statewide DORA study includes 1,336 offenders (Probation = 929, Parole = 407). One probationer was dropped from the sample from previous reports due to not being classified as DORA in UDC records. This preliminary update reports on outcomes up to July 1, 2012. A full update of 2012 DORA statewide findings will be available November 1, 2012.

**DORA Outcomes**

- Most participants have exited DORA supervision. Successful supervision completion rates have increased slightly. Treatment completion rates are relatively unchanged.

**Recidivism**

- Return to prison and recidivism rates are higher for parolees than probationers
- UCJC is working with CCJJ and the Department of Corrections to identify and match DORA participants with an appropriate comparison group for the 2013 report
