





Plan, conserve, develop and protect Utah's water resources.




Legislative Authority

- Oversee the development of Bear River and Lake Powell Pipeline projects.


State Water Planning Process

- Publish Final





■ Total Potable + Secondary Use ■ Potable Use




Board of Water Resources Funding

- The Board funds water projects that conserve, protect, or more efficiently use present water supplies, develop new water, or provide flood control
- Board has constructed nearly 1,400 projects since 1947
- Legislature has appropriated \$322M
- Board has made loans totaling \$713M
- Total project value over \$2B
- Board has only had one default (and another in potentially in progress)






Board of Water Resources Funding FY 2013 Estimate
