BUDGET BRIEF

## **SUMMARY**

The Division of State History administers five programs including: Administration, Libraries and Collections, Public History and Education, Preservation, and grants. The mission of the division is to "preserve and share Utah's past for the present and the future." The division provides services to entities statewide. The Utah Historical Society is the fundraising arm of the Division of State History.

## **ISSUES AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

The subcommittee should consider the following items in its deliberations:

# **Base Budget Adoption**

For the State History budget, the Fiscal Analyst recommends an FY 2014 budget of \$3,049,500 and a budget of \$102,400 for the State Historical Society as shown in the budget detail on pages 3 and 4.

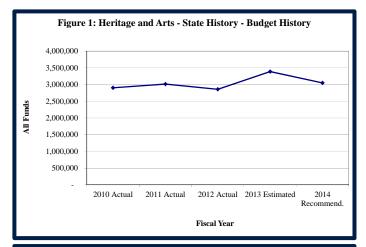

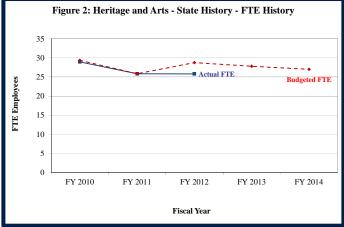
#### Federal Funds

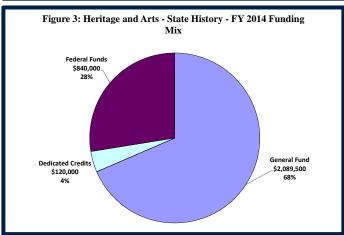

# Intent Language

Under Section 63J-1-603 of the Utah Code, the Legislature intends that the \$102,000 in Dedicated Credits provided by Item 2, Chapter 10, Laws of Utah 2012, for the Department of Heritage and Arts (Community and Culture) – Historical Society line item not lapse at the close of Fiscal Year 2013.





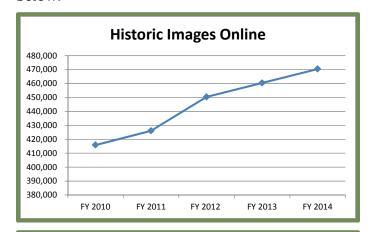


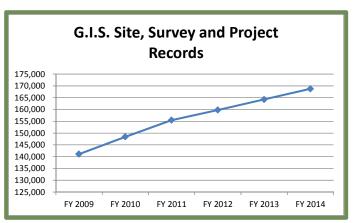
### ACCOUNTABILITY DETAIL

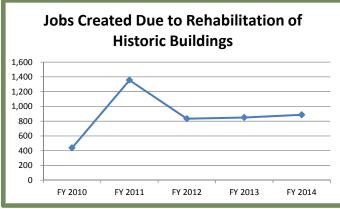
State History helps communities make the most of their heritage resources with grants, technical assistance, support, and historical documents.

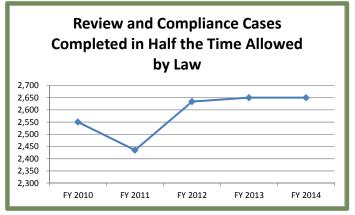
State History preserves and provides public access to documents, articles, and photos that tell the story of Utah's past. To this end they add additional documents each year as shown in the chart below titles Historic Photographic and Documentary Images Online.

The preservation tax credit keeps federal dollars in Utah and encourages preservation. Historic preservation creates household income and jobs. The number of local jobs created due to rehabilitation tax credits is shown in the chart below. To measure processing efficiency the division looks at the number of compliance cases completed in half the time allowed by law. The history of this measure is shown below.









## **BUDGET DETAIL**

Funding for the Division of State History and the Utah Historical Society is used to provide personnel support, grants, preservation services, and general history oversight.
