ISSUE BRIEF

The Division of Parks and Recreation has reorganized its fee structure this year. Instead of listing the fee for each park and activity separately, they now have a maximum fee they can charge by type of activity. This will allow each park manager to set reasonable fees for their park within the allowed limit and reduce them during slow times in order to attract more visitors.
