SUNSET REVIEW PROCESS

Legislative Management Committee assigns sunset reviews to interim committees

INTERIM COMMITTEE REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

Committee options:

- Take no Action on Sunset Date (which will result in repeal of the law on the sunset date)
- Extend Sunset Date (up to 10 years) with or without substantive changes to the law
- Remove Sunset Provision
 (which means the law remains and will not be reviewed in the future) with or without substantive changes to the law

Recommendation is made by the committee via a motion, or optionally, the committee may prepare and draft a bill to reflect the recommendation

Submits Recommendation LEGISLATIVE
MANAGEMENT
COMMITTEE REVIEW

Legislative Management Committee accepts, rejects, or modifies the committee recommendation LMC chooses to take no action on sunset date

LMC takes no action (which will result in repeal of the law on the sunset date)

LMC chooses to extend the sunset date or remove the sunset provision LMC assigns sponsor and drafts the bill (or accepts the existing committee bill if a committee bill has been submitted and adopted by LMC)

Despite the LMC recommendation, an individual legislator may independently choose to draft a bill or amendment to:

- (1) keep the existing sunset date;
- (2) extend the sunset date; or
- (3) repeal the sunset provision
