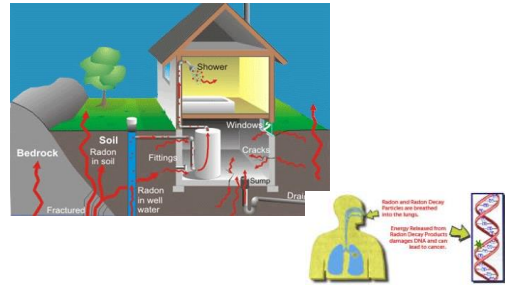




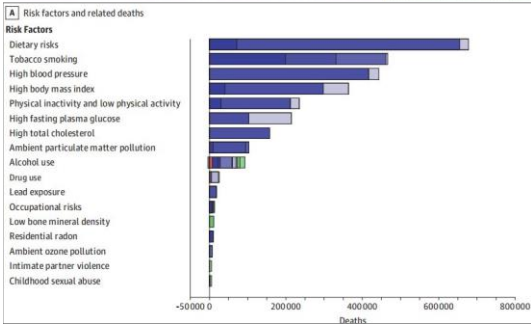

Lung Cancer Risk Factor

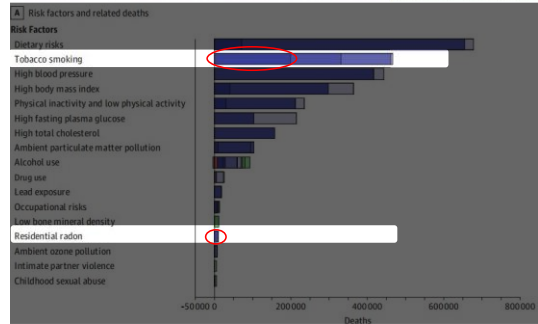


Risk Factors and Related Deaths



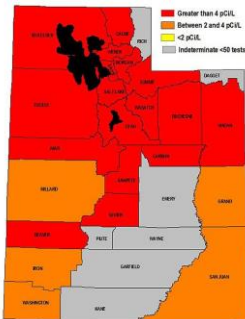

Radon Awareness in Utah



- 52% of Utahns correctly identified lung cancer as a health condition associated with radon exposure
- 14% do not see radon as a health risk
- 13% do not know what radon is
- 80% have never tested their homes

26-7-7. Radon Awareness Campaign.

The department shall, in consultation with the Division of Radiation Control, develop a statewide electronic awareness campaign to educate the public regarding:

- (1) the existence and prevalence of radon gas in buildings and structures;
- (2) the health risks associated with radon gas;
- (3) options for radon gas testing; and
- (4) options for radon gas remediation.
