## Efficiencies realized:

- With increased number of customers we were able to serve from an average of 7100 per month to 9600 a month while reducing our wait times.
- Reduced wait times during busiest time of day from 10 minutes to 8 minutes

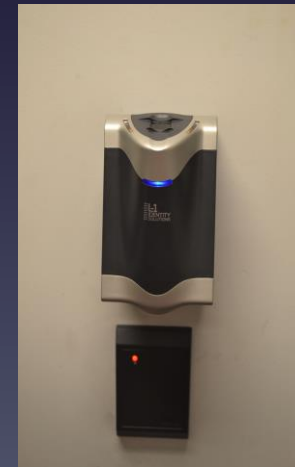

Utilizing internal savings DPS is centralizing and streamlining the evidence process to improve tracking, oversight and disposal.



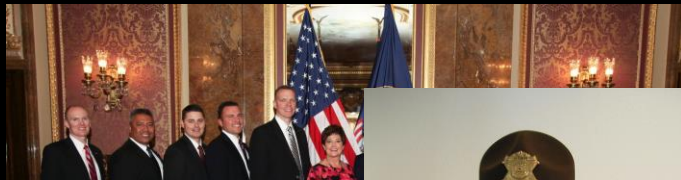
# Utah Highway Patrol

- 2015 starting salary \$18.17- top range \$27.81

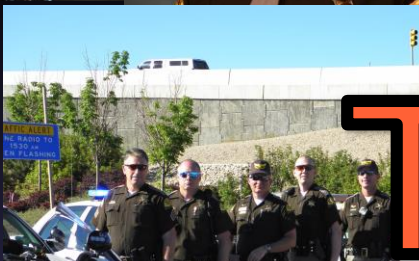

## 2015 DNA funding update

### DNA Positions (5 new positions \$500,000)

- 2 individuals offered employment (start date July)
- 3 individuals currently going through background check

### DNA Robotic Work Stations (\$1,000,000)

- Received two stations and expect delivery of third in July 2015

## \$750,000 Rape Kit funding

- Received 1,187 untested kits- 304 submitted

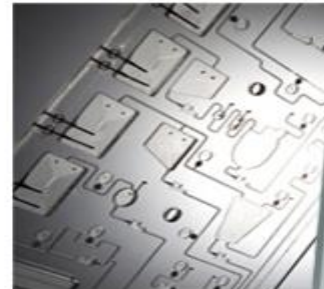

## Rapid DNA

- Technology exists that will provide for DNA testing to be done by local law enforcement agencies in some cases
- Rapid DNA machines would be regionally placed throughout the state where DPS will provide the machine and the local agencies will pay for the testing





# UHP



## Helicopter

- 2012- 79 rescues
- 2013- 112 rescues
- 2014- 125 rescues

2<sup>nd</sup> helicopter is 22 years old and will need to be replaced



# UHP



## Manpower

- In the past 30 years UHP has added 27 Trooper positions
- Same time period there has been double the growth in population, vehicle miles traveled and registered vehicles
- UHP will be working on a thorough study of the issue to determine the needed amount of additional troopers.
