Why on Agenda

Excerpt from April 22, 2015 letter from President Niederhauser and Speaker Hughes to Senator Bramble and Representative Peterson:

“We ask that you look at all the reports that your committee is required by statute to receive each year. Of these reports, decide which ones you no longer see as necessary or of sufficient value. We then ask that you prepare a bill that will eliminate the reports your interim committee no longer sees as pertinent.”

Reports by Category

- Number of statutorily required reports = 16
 - Reports That Are New = 4
 - Reports That Are a Fundamental Part of an Approval Process = 2
 - Reports That Are Triggered by an Event= 4
 - Report That Is Given to Committee Only If Requested = 1
 - Reports Not Grouped in above Categories = 5

Reports That Are New

- Department of Administrative Services - Coordinator of Resource Stewardship
- Utah Motor Vehicle Franchise Advisory Board
- Sichuan Province Partnership New Entity
- Abuse-deterrent Opioid Analgesic Drug Products

Reports That Are a Fundamental Part of an Approval Process

- Uniform Building Code Commission
- Utah Fire Prevention Board

Reports That Are Triggered by an Event

- Uniform Building Code Commission - an emergency amendment to the State Construction Code
- Utah Fire Prevention Board - an emergency amendment to the State Fire Code
- Implementation of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act
- Insurance Department - agreements related to non-admitted insurance taxes

Report That Is Given to Committee Only If Requested

- Utah Science Technology and Research (USTAR) Governing Authority

Reports Not Grouped in Previous Categories

- Department of Insurance -- Workers' Compensation Insurance Report
- Labor Commission -- Workers' Compensation – Information Regarding Hearings to Review the Decision of an Employer or Insurance Carrier
- Worker Classification Coordinated Enforcement Council
- Utah Capital Investment Corporation in consultation with the Utah Capital Investment Board
- Occupational and Professional Licensure Review Committee
