

College Success Starts Early USHE Partnership Initiatives



Before High School: Utah Scholars Initiative

• 32,000 eighth graders received Utah Scholars prep message in their classrooms via volunteers.

• 939 Utah Scholars presentations were given by 221 volunteers.

• 2,896 high school students graduated with the Utah Scholars medallion.

The first step to college

• 79% Regents' Scholarship applicants were Utah Scholars.

High School: Concurrent Enrollment

• 1 in 3

High School: College Application Week

- 20,000+ high school seniors in 84 high schools completed a college application during the school day.
- Emphasis on low-income, first generation students.





High School to College: College Ready Grants

\$600,000 for mini-grants for partnerships between institutions & K-12

Requires attainment of specific goals, including:

- Increase number of students receiving 8th grade college prepintroduction
- Increase number of students achieving ACT college readiness benchmarks
- Increase number of students taking Math 1030/1040/1050 and/or 4-years of math in high school
- Increase number of students applying for Regents' Scholarship



Statewide college preparation scholarship

26% increase in awards from 2014

Scholarship benefits: Higher GPA, fuller course load, more timely completion rates.




Annual Counselor Conference

Online courses and degrees


- 81 degrees available entirely online.
- 1 in 4 students take an online-only course.
- Utilization of online courses has grown more than 5-fold since 2011.

But...

- More than 85% of students who enroll in online courses take a majority of their courses on-campus.
- Less than 3% of full-time students are enrolled totally online
- Most "100%" online students are part-time, over 25 yrs old.

Despite availability of online courses/degrees, students prefer using online courses to supplement a traditional on-campus schedule.





Efficiencies and Re-Prioritizing

USHE institutions added 79 new certificate and degree programs in 2015:

- 4 Doctorate programs
- 4 Master's degrees
- 8 Graduate certificates
- **25** Baccalaureate degrees
- 13 Minors
- 4 Associate in Applied Science degrees
- 4 Certificates of completion
- 13 Certificates of proficiency

26 programs that no longer met the needs of today's students were discontinued.
