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RELEVANT STATUTES*

Online computer adaptive tests

§ 53A-1-603

(2) [U]nder U-PASS, the State Board of Education shall annually require a school district or charter school to administer:

(a) as determined by the State Board of Education, statewide criterion-referenced tests or online computer adaptive tests in grades 3 through 12 and courses in basic academic subjects of the core standards for Utah public schools

§ 53A-1-603

(9) Beginning with the 2016–17 school year, for all students in grade 11, a school district or charter school may waive the obligation to administer a test required under Subsection (2)(a).

Benchmark reading assessments

§ 53A-1-606.6

(2) The [State Board of Education] shall approve a benchmark assessment for use statewide by school districts and charter schools to assess the reading competency of students in grades one, two, and three as provided by this section.

(3) A school district or charter school shall:

(a) administer benchmark assessments to students in grades one, two, and three at the beginning, middle, and end of the school year using the benchmark assessment approved by the [State Board of Education]

College readiness assessments

§ 53A-1-611

(2) In addition to its responsibilities under 53A-1-603 through 53A-1-605, the State Board of Education shall:

(a) adopt college readiness assessments for secondary students; and
 (b) require a school district or charter school to administer the college readiness assessments adopted by the State Board of Education.

(4)(a) Except as provided in Subsection (4)(b), the State Board of Education shall require a school district or charter school to administer a test adopted under Subsection (3)(a) to all students in grade 11.

Online writing assessments

§ 53A-1-603

(2) [U]nder U-PASS, the State Board of Education shall annually require each school district and charter school, as applicable, to administer:

(b) an online writing assessment to all students in grades 5 and 8

Civics test

§ 53A-13-109.5

(2)(a) [The State Board of Education] shall require:

(i) a public school student who graduates on or after January 1, 2016, to pass a basic civics test as a condition for receiving a high school diploma
