



Policies in States Like Utah

North Dakota

Vote-by-mail in counties / Postmark day before election

- No additional policy

Policies in States Like Utah

Washington

Statewide vote-by-mail / Postmark on election day

- Meter postage dated stamp does not count as postmark
- Ballot drop boxes




Policies in States Like Utah

Oregon

Statewide vote-by-mail / Receipt on election day (8 p.m.)

- Ballot drop boxes / locator
- 1 box / 30,000 active voters (2 minimum)
- Return to any drop box in the state
- Statewide media blitz for ballot deadline



Policies in States Like Utah

Colorado

Statewide vote-by-mail / Receipt on election day (7 p.m.)

- Ballot drop boxes
- 1 box / 30,000 active voters
- Return to any drop box in the state
- “Scooping” on Election Day
- Rerouting rural mail
