

## Homeless to Housing TANF Award Summary

**Background** - H.B 3 of the 2016 General Session authorized the Department of Workforce Service (DWS) to make available up to \$2,250,000 of TANF funding for eligible programs identified by H.B. 436 via the Homeless to Housing Restricted Account under the direction of the State Homeless Coordinating Committee (SHCC) . The SHCC has met since the passage of the legislation in May, August and September to consider proposals. The SHCC issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) in June 2016 to consider applications statewide that met the criteria established by the SHCC in conjunction with the requirements of H.B. 436. The following descriptions represent the awards approved by the SHCC.

### Awards

**Homelessness Diversion Programs** - These programs perform assessments to households seeking placement into emergency shelter to determine alternatives that would be superior to a shelter placement and connect those households to that placement option in lieu of a shelter placement if applicable.

Bear River AOG - \$56,637

Family Connection Center (Davis County) - \$39,973

Friends of Switchpoint (Washington County) - \$44,544

Salt Lake Community Action Program - \$100,000

South Valley Sanctuary (Salt Lake County - Domestic Violence) - \$36,256

St. Anne's Center (Weber County) - \$11,520

Community Action Services and Food Bank (Utah/Wasatch/Summit County) - \$51,200

**Rapid Re-Housing Programs** - These programs take households staying in the shelter and provides short term housing assistance with case management to exit them from shelter to a housing option.

The Road Home - \$100,000

Your Community Connection (Weber County) - \$24,432

### Other Programs

The Road Home Connected Impact Project - \$100,000

This involves multi-agency referrals and housing supports for long term housing stability.

VOA Youth Resource Center & Shelter - \$100,000

This funding will help support the operations and programming for the recently completed resource center.

First Step House Homeless Father Housed Initiative expansion - \$99,995

This program helps support the housing placement and supports for this targeted population.

Salt Lake County - \$1,200,000

These funds will be utilized to provide funding to operate the Midvale Family Shelter year round. Prior to the 2016 Legislative Session, the Midvale Shelter, operated by The Road Home was only open during the winter season per their conditional use permit issued by Midvale City. Senate Bill 169 enables The Road Home to operate the Midvale Shelter year round. Although no funding was attached to SB169 to fund the operations, this effort was done in concert with the aforementioned HB 436, to enable full utilization of the homeless shelter assets in the State. Salt Lake County will help facilitate the deployment of these TANF funds to keep the Midvale Shelter operating beginning July 1, 2016.
