**3. DUI Impound Fees**

*The committee will receive a presentation from the Chairman of the State Tax Commission regarding the Motor Vehicle Division's processing of refund requests for DUI impound fees made by a driver who received a "no action" letter from the Driver License Division. A request for a refund must currently be received by the Motor Vehicle Division within 30 days of a "no action" letter being mailed by the Driver License Division to a driver arrested for a DUI. This short timeline has led to refund requests being denied by the Motor Vehicle Division after being received outside of the 30-day period. Other statutes that provide for the refund of costs or fees related to motor vehicles allow a six-month period for requesting reimbursement.*
