*The Department of Health recommends the repeal of subsection 26-18-2.6(8)(c)--the Medicaid Dental Benefits and Pilot Program report. The provision was added in 2012 and was permissive, allowing the Department of Health, Division of Medicaid and Health Finance, to establish a dental health care delivery system and payment reform pilot program for Medicaid dental benefits to increase access to cost effective and quality dental health care by increasing the number of dentists available for Medicaid dental services. To date, the division has not established the pilot.

**The Department of Health recommends the repeal of Subsection 26-18-407(5)--the Medicaid Waiver for Autism Spectrum Disorder reporting requirement. The Medicaid Autism Waiver was created in 2012. In 2015, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services began requiring states to provide autism spectrum disorder-related services to children under 21 as part of the Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment program, rather than through the home and community based services waivers. The division is allowing currently-enrolled children to age out of the Medicaid Wavier for Autism Spectrum Disorder. Once all of the children age out in the next few years, the division will want to discontinue the program. The division recommends having the reporting requirement repealed because the program is being phased out.

Reports highlighted in yellow are recommended for repeal because they are expired or will be expired by the end of 2016.
