The task force will follow up on actions taken in response to this motion.

At its last meeting, the task force voted to send a letter to the United States Department of Labor, and to encourage legislative leadership to send a separate letter, in support of comments prepared by the National Academy of State Health Policy in response to a Department of Labor proposed rule that could affect state's ability to collect health insurance information from certain self-insured entities.
