23	Section 1. Section 10-3-916 is amended to read:	
24	10-3-916. Appointment of recorder and treasurer in a city of third, fourth, or	
25	fifth class or a town Vacancies in office.	
26	(1) (a) In each city of the third, fourth, or fifth class and in each town, [on or before the	
27	first Monday in February following a municipal election,] the mayor, with the advice and	
28	consent of the city council, shall appoint a qualified person to [each of the offices] the office of	
29	city recorder and a qualified person to the office of city treasurer.	
30	(b) The mayor and city council shall use best efforts to ensure the office of city	
31	recorder or office of city treasurer is not vacant.	
32	(2) The city recorder is ex officio the city auditor and shall perform the duties of that

- 34 (3) The mayor, with the advice and consent of the council, may also appoint and fill vacancies in all offices provided for by law or ordinance.
