Statutory Direction

Utah Code Section 53A-1-102.5. Planning for Utah's public education system.

(1) Before November 30, 2016, the State Board of Education shall:

(a)(i) prepare a report that summarizes, for the last 15 years or more, the policies and programs established by, and the performance history of, the state's public education system; and

(ii) prepare a formal 10-year plan for the state's public education system, including recommendations to:

(A) repeal outdated policies and programs; and

(B) clarify and correlate current policies and programs; and

(b) submit the report and plan described in Subsection (1)(a) to the Education Interim Committee for review and recommendations.

Utah Code Comparison, 2000 & 2015

- Snapshot view of the Title 53A as it existed in 2000 and 2015
- Simple comparison between the two years
 - Illustrates level of policy/program development in Utah Code
 - 14 new Chapters and 85 new Parts in 2015 that didn't exist in 2000

- Report and Matrix should be tools, not static reports
 - Opportunities exist for studies that are more focused and can be examined in-depth.
 - This study can be a useful tool for additional examination.
- Stakeholders can contribute to policy and program discussions with critical questions
 - Establish clear definition of problem to be solved
 - What are the goals and desired outcomes?
 - What current policies/programs address this problem?
 - How does previous work inform the intended goals/outcomes?
 - What options are available to best address issue or problem?
