Committee Motion to increase Teacher Licensing Fund Cap in FY2017 to fund FTE and indirect costs

Purpose/Justification:

- Current projections show the UPPAC/Educator Licensing budget as approximately \$200,000 under current funding cap
- Causes include:
 - increase in indirect costs for FY 2017
 - correction of misaligned FTE duties to funding sources

Specific Requirements/Programming:

- Increase Educator Licensing funding cap for FY 2017 by \$200,000 in dedicated credit revenue.
- Any excess authorization laps back to the restricted fund for FY 2018.

Performance Measures/Projected Outcomes:

- USBE will maintain the current level of support for LEAs and educators in regards to educator licensing operations.
- USBE will maintain the current timelines and rigor for UPPAC investigations into educator misconduct.
- USBE is ensuring that funds are spend prudently and with authorization, while staying within the budget procedures act limitations.

Impact if not Funded:

	Purpose/Justification:	Specific Requirements/Programming:
•	Current projections show the fund balances will be exhausted prior to the end of FY 2018. By legislative action in FY 2014, UPPAC/licensing fees are currently set at a level such that expenditures exceed revenue. Board and legislative changes to educator licensing are currently being considered, it is difficult to project anticipated expenditures accurately; therefore, a return to previous levels is proposed and should provide time for the Board and Legislature to finalize the changes to the system.	 Set UPPAC/Licensing fees for FY 2018 to the levels established prior to the change in FY 2014 with the following exceptions: Duplicate license fee would remain at \$10 rather than previous level of \$20. Endorsement related fees would be equalized to \$40 rather than previous levels of \$35/\$45. UPPAC fee increased by \$20 from FY 2014 levels (if necessary).
