1. Page 6, Line 168 through Page 7, Line 185:

168 (18) "Tier one job" means a new annual job held by an employee who:

(a) served in the active military, naval, or air service and who was discharged or

170 released under conditions other than dishonorable;

171 (b) suffers from a disability; or

172 (c) was found guilty of a crime and sentenced by a court to a prison term (control of the c

(d) was not a resident of Utah within the 12 months prior to holding the job }.

174 { (19) "Tier three job" means all new annual jobs that are not tier one jobs or tier two
