1. Page 30, Lines 909 through 914:

909 (4) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (4)(b), a qualified medical provider may not

910 recommend a medical cannabis treatment to more than {2} 1.5 % of the total amount of medical

911 cannabis patient cardholders.

912 (b) If a qualified medical provider receives payment from an insurance plan for

services provided under this chapter, then the patient whose insurance plan was billed does not 913

914 count toward the  $\{-2\}$  1.5 % patient cap described in Subsection (4)(a).
