

AMENDED NOTE

This bill repeals the health care assistant registration act. This will result in the loss of revenue to the Commerce Service Fund in the amount of \$60,000. It will also allow for the reduction in the Commerce Department's budget of a similar amount.

The bill requires a criminal background check for certain individuals associated with health care facilities. Ongoing expenses are estimated at \$63,000 annually, but one-time start-up costs will require approximately \$7,000, funded from the General Fund in FY 1999.
