Passage of this bill could increase General Fund Revenue by \$2,284,000 in FY 2000 and by \$2,741,000 in FY 2001. Local fund revenues could increase by \$649,000 and \$779,000 in the respective fiscal years. Transit tax revenues could increase by \$120,000 in FY 2000 and \$144,000 in FY 2001.

**Individual and Business Impact**

Passage of this bill could increase the subscription costs for individuals by approximately \$6.50 annually. For newspaper purchases from a vending machine, the daily cost will increase by approximately 5 cents and the Sunday newspaper will increase by approximately 10 cents.
