It is estimated that this legislation will result in at least 100 additional individuals being civilly committed. The impact on the public mental health system is estimated at about \$2.3 million (\$882,000 General Fund). Additional costs to the Court system is estimated at \$86,500 (General Fund), including \$2,500 in one-time costs.
