

**State Impact**

This substitute bill appropriates \$90,000 from the General Fund to the Division of Parks and Recreation in FY 2002 only, for development of Old Iron Town. This bill also appropriates \$10,000 from ongoing General Funds in FY 2002, for operating costs at Old Iron Town.
