## **State Impact**

Provisions of this bill increases the recycling fee for new tires purchased from \$.85 to \$1 per tire. It is estimated that an additional \$330,000 will be deposited to the Waste Tire Recycling Expendable Trust Fund. The bill also increases fees paid to waste tire recyclers and transportes. Those increased expenditures are expected to equal \$330,000.
