

State Impact

Provisions of this bill increases the recycling fee for new tires purchased from \$.85 to \$1 per tire. It is estimated that an additional \$330,000 will be deposited to the Waste Tire Recycling Expendable Trust Fund. The bill also increases fees paid to waste tire recyclers and transporters. Those increased expenditures are expected to equal \$330,000.

Individual and Business Impact

Individuals will be required to pay an additional \$.15 per tire as recycling fee. Counties will be required to pay 40 percent of the cost to remove abandoned waste tire piles. It is estimated to cost between \$50,000 and \$70,000 annually
