State Impact

For the cases going to the State Juvenile Court, those cases formerly held by a hearings officer would have to be seen by a judge. Additional cost to the courts is approximately \$48,300. Revenue from 2,000 reinstatements (fee) would be \$50,000 to the Transportation Restricted-Public Safety. Costs for Drivers License processing and mailing would be approximately \$8,900 in the first year and \$6,400 thereafter.
