

**AMENDED NOTE**

**State Impact**

This bill appropriates \$3 million from the General Fund. Of this \$3 million, \$2 million replaces current General Fund Restricted-Tobacco Settlement monies, the other \$1 million increases anti-tobacco funding to the Department of Health. The \$2 million of Tobacco Settlement funds are appropriated to the Department of Health for anti-tobacco programs.

The bill also requires that the available interest earnings from the permanent state trust fund be appropriated to the Department of Health. These earnings are estimated at \$429,800 in FY 2002 and \$617,800 in FY 2003.
