

State Impact

Passage of this bill would require an appropriation of \$5,168,000 to the Department of Transportation to pay for staff and legal fees associated with condemnation cases. The Attorney General would also require an appropriation of \$661,800 to implement the provisions of the bill.

Individual and Business Impact
