

State Impact

Regulatory fees provided in the bill are estimated to be \$1,057,800 in FY 2002. The bill also requires an annual fee of \$2,000,000 to provide for perpetual care. The taxes authorized in the bill are estimated to be as much as \$34,043,000 if waste disposal streams continue at present levels and all waste is taxed.
