**State Impact**

The number of anticipated cases brought under this bill is very small and can be accommodated within existing budgets at both the state and local levels.

**Individual and Business Impact**

Wholesale and retail firearms sales firms will have some additional costs for signs which will probably be passed on to consumers through pricing. The bill also limits the damage awards to \$500,000 for failure to secure firearms from juveniles.
