

**State Impact**

This bill is estimated to generate approximately \$17,500 in General Fund revenue from fines and penalties. An appropriation of \$12,000 from the General Fund to the Labor Commission is required to implement the provisions of the bill.

**Individual and Business Impact**

The bill enacts new penalties and increases fines for others. This could increase costs to offenders by as much as 50 percent. A portion of this revenue will go back to the claimant.
