

State Impact

The Tax Commission - Motor Vehicle operations will require approximately \$15,000 for a one-time reprogramming expense to accommodate the changes in this bill. Public Safety would expect to lose approximately \$140,000 from reduced fee income.

There will also be some incidental costs associated with rulemaking regarding safety inspection apprenticeship program for high schools. These costs can be accommodated within existing budgets.
