

State Impact

It is estimated that the provisions of this bill require an ongoing General Fund appropriation to the Department of Corrections of \$24,000 starting the first year and increasing to \$30,000 the second year. There may also be a similar fiscal impact to local governments that use electronic monitoring devices.

Individual and Business Impact

Individuals convicted of the offense established in this legislation may have a fine up to \$2,500 and/or an extended penalty which could include additional jail or prison time affecting personal earnings.
