

State Impact

The State could pay more for electric power. Consumers could also pay more which would result in revenue increases in local sales, excise and franchise fees. Because of the range of options, exact estimates are not given.

Individual and Business Impact

Consumers could pay more for electric power depending on current rate structures and production costs or savings to the generator. First year costs could range from \$5,000,000 to \$55,000,000 depending on the types of renewable energy available. These costs escalate from year to year until 2008 when they could be between \$50,000,000 and \$600,000,000.
