

**State Impact**

The provisions of this bill may provide some small cost savings to Human Service agencies by allowing a few disabled students to remain in the public education system past their 22nd birthday. School districts may experience a financial impact through implementation of this bill. Funding for these students is currently allocated on an annual basis through the Minimum School Program. This legislation could reduce potential cost savings, as a district would keep these students until the end of the school year, not just until reaching age 22. The provisions of this bill may be handled within current allocations.
