

**FIFTH SPECIAL SESSION**

**State Impact**

This bill allows prescriptions that are issued to individuals in nursing facilities, but are not used, to be returned and redistributed under specific conditions. The bill also requires generic drugs to be prescribed to Medicaid recipients, unless a medical necessity is demonstrated. It is anticipated that these two actions will result in a savings of \$1,153,300.
