

State Impact

Provisions of this bill establish a Resource Conservation Advisory Committee. Committee members that are not state employees may receive per diem and reimbursement for expenses incurred in the performance of committee duties. Associated costs may be handled within existing resources and are dependent on the number of committee meetings and travel distances of committee members.

The bill creates a Resource Conservation Program for school districts and directs school districts to appoint a Resource Conservation Manager. Costs associated with the implementation of this program may be handled within existing resources.
