Automobile Homicide Amendments

State Impact

This bill creates a new second degree offense when an offender is convicted of automobile homicide and has a prior DUI conviction. While there would be no fiscal impact in FY 2004 or FY 2005, costs in future years could appreciate depending on the number of inmates sentenced under provisions of this bill. It is anticipated that \$52,000 General Fund will be required in FY 2006 and \$100,000 ongoing General Fund required in FY 2007 and thereafter.

Individual and Business Impact

Those convicted under the provisions of this bill may spend more time in prison. This may reduce their earning ability and consequently reduce their income over the time they spend in prison.
