

**State Impact**

This bill would generate an estimated \$120,000 in new revenues for the General Fund Restricted - Off-Highway Vehicle Account. The Division of Parks and Recreation would need \$16,900 appropriated for increased administrative expenses.

This bill may be impacted by the coordination clause in First Substitute House Bill 220.
